




Karolis Chvedukas, a <u>Lithuanian soccer player</u> who was with Marijampolė City and made 20 appearances for the national team, has died, officials said Monday. He was 32.

The Lithuanian Football Association released a statement on his passing, saying he "unexpectedly died." The cause of death was not made known.


June 16, 2023 (Scotland) – 34 year old Scots youth soccer coach Tony Spencer died suddenly on June 16, 2023.



June 6, 2023 (Latvia) – 38 year old Latvian professional soccer player and star Gints Freimanis died on June 6, 2023. He was diagnosed with skin cancer in Oct. 2021. In Jan doctors informed him the cancer had spread to his brain.



May 24, 2023 (UK) – Wolverhampton, UK – 15 yo soccer player Myles Christie died suddenly from a cardiac arrest on May 24, 2023.



May 23, 2023 (Spain) - Morrazo, Spain - 36 year old former professional soccer player and triathlete Juan Beascoechea collapsed and died suddenly while at work on May 23, 2023 "In recent years he had discovered his passion for triathlon".



May 3, 2023 (France) - French Goalkeeper Mathieu Villain, age 38, died suddenly on May 3, 2023 following a heart attack. He was a former goalkeeper of Chauny, Laon, Prémontré, Tergnier & Arsenal Club.



The former goalkeeper with multiple clubs, notably in Chaunois, died suddenly on Wednesday May 3, at only 38 years old.

THE "rock", as his former coach at Arsenal Club, Farid Boudaber, affectionately nicknamed him, has collapsed and leaves the great Axon football family in pain, mainly in the Chaunois country, from which he kept the goals of many clubs. Aged only 38, Mathieu Villain died suddenly on Wednesday May 3, following a heart attack.

Sad news that shocked and moved Frédéric Baudin, his exeducator at US Chauny, where he was understudy for former pro Thibault Maqua and played three matches in CFA2. Iranian soccer player dies of cardiac arrest on football pitch

A young Iranian soccer player has died of cardiac arrest on a football pitch in the province of Mazandaran, northern Iran.

Footage showing latest images of Amir Hossein Shirchi has made the rounds of social media in Iran.

The 23-year-old was from the city of Babol and died during a match in the second division of the Iranian football league.

Shirchi previously played for Padideh of Mashhad, Khooneh Be Khonneh of Babol and Darya of Babol. He was also once invited to the Junior National Team (Team Melli) of Iran.

April 10, 2023 – Macon, GA – 21 year old Baba Agbaje, member of Mercer University men's soccer team, collapsed during a game, suffered a cardiac arrest and died. (click here)

A 21-YEAR-OLD university soccer player tragically passed away after suddenly collapsing during a game on Monday, April 10, 2023.


Baba Agbaje, a student at Mercer University in Macon, <u>Georgia</u> reportedly went into <u>cardiac arrest on the field</u>.



March 7, 2023 – 29 year old Siphamandla 'Spepe' Mtolo, a professional soccer player in South Africa, died suddenly during morning training. (click here)



March 5, 2023 - 21 year old Moustapha Sylla, soccer player in Ivory Coast, died after collapsing on the field during a league game with cardiac arrest (click here).



Feb. 11, 2023 – 25 year old Arne Espeel, Belgian goalkeeper, died after collapsing while playing for an amateur team. He had saved a penalty and moments later he fell to the ground. He died in the hospital (click here).

Arne Espeel, a Belgian soccer goalkeeper, has tragically passed away after he collapsed following a saved penalty kick during a game over the weekend.

He was only 25.

The terrible incident happened during Winkel Sport B's game against Westrozebeke at Sportpark Terschueren in West Flanders Province on Feb. 11.

When Winkel was up 2-1 in the second half of the game, Espeel saved a penalty kick ... but a few seconds later, according to local reports, he dropped to the ground on the pitch.

Medical professionals tried to save Espeel with a defibrillator, but he was transported to a local hospital where he was pronounced dead.

An autopsy was scheduled for Monday to determine the cause of death.

Jan. 6, 2023 – 58 year old Gianluca Vialli died suddenly following battle with pancreatic cancer.

<u>Gianluca Vialli</u> was an iconic <u>soccer</u> player and manager who played as a striker.

He <u>passed away</u> on January 6, 2023, at the age of 58 following a <u>battle</u> <u>with pancreatic cancer</u>.

My Take...

14 professional soccer players dead within last 6 months, age range 15 to 58.

Causes of death:

- 5 cardiac arrests and sudden deaths while playing a game
- 1 cardiac arrest while sitting on a terrace
- 1 cardiac arrest while at work
- 3 heart attacks
- 2 unknown causes
- 2 turbo cancers (skin, pancreas)


Just like with NFL players I wrote about yesterday, maybe not all of these deaths will be COVID-19 vaccine related but probably most of them will be.

This is the same pattern of "causes of deaths" we see with other COVID-19 vaccinated athletes. Fascinatingly, 5 deaths occurred while playing a game.
