

# Alberta Health Services Almost Killed a Girl with Remdesivir. Now, Sick Again, She Recovered Without Risking AHS Hospitals

Dear Dr. Makis,

What would be a normal dosage of Ivermectin for a 130 lb. woman? I have liquid Ivermectin [REDACTED] and the syringe measures in mL. I've been taking 4 mL/day since getting sick with a flu that is as bad as I had 2 years ago and my daughter almost died from it. She went to the [REDACTED], AB hospital with breathing problems and they put her on a ventilator. They wanted to put her on Remdezivere but I told them specifically not to. The doctor said that would have been his choice but they had other things. She has Downs Syndrome and is 170 lbs. I don't think we knew enough at the time to keep giving her the ivermectin when she was sick and we stopped because it didn't seem to be doing anything. I was giving her 3 mL a day and quit but did 3mL/day when we got her back home. Now she's sick again but it doesn't seem to be getting very bad and I'm almost over it. Should I continue giving us 3 or 4mL doses? I see that you suggested only 0.5 mg for a man with diverticulitis and it seems like I'm way over-doing it?

Thank you so much and I want you to know I continue to pray for you and your family daily.

## Another Tool for Infections - Chlorine Dioxide

- I had a bad flu a few months ago and it wasn't going away with a few days of

Ivermectin.

- I remember trying Chlorine Dioxide out of curiosity and it was gone in what seemed like 24 hours but may have been 2 days.

Thank you, Dr. Makis. I started her on it this morning -- 4 drops of each in water -- and gave her another dose at noon. This evening she had her ivermectin (4mL). I'm thinking I will do Chlorine dioxide morning and noon and ivermectin in the evening. She is eating but her cough is getting worse and she is definitely "low" today. No walk, very stuffed up. She's not in bed, though. She's looking at a photo album right now. Obviously I'm worried because of how bad it got 2 years ago. I'm also giving her zinc, oregano oil caps, vit. C and D3. I'm feeling a bit guilty taking up your time so unless you think I'm doing something wrong or should do something more, you don't have to answer this email. I am incredibly grateful for the time you've spent with me and am feeling confident using the ivermectin again.

On Wednesday, November 27, 2024 at 09:18:05 a.m. MST, [REDACTED] > wrote:

Thank you! And thank you for giving me a time-line for the chlorine dioxide. This will be her second day and I've given her her first dose. She woke up an hour ago and is looking better. She says she's feeling better; she says she's ready to go for our walk today. I think yesterday was the peak. And there was hardly any coughing last night. I'll give her one more dose of chlorine dioxide this noon and 4mL ivermectin this evening. Then maybe I'll just continue with vitamins after that if she still seems to be doing better. As I write this, she hasn't even been blowing her nose and says she can breathe through her nose.

Dr. Makis, I can't thank you enough for giving me your advice through this. The hospital experience 2 years ago was harrowing. She was having trouble breathing so I called the ambulance but when they put the oxygen mask on her she was immediately calm and on the way to the hospital she was joking and cheerful under the oxygen mask. At the hospital the night doctor said she had to go on a ventilator but luckily I was able to say no Remdesivir. After 3 days the doctor we had since that next morning said to take the ventilator out even though the technician said there wasn't enough air getting through when they tested to see if it was okay to take it out. Dr. [REDACTED] said take it out anyway. I don't now believe she should ever have been on it in the first place.

All this to say, it is very comforting to have your advice through this!
