**Premier Danielle Smith's Office interferes with Court matters when it comes to silencing honest, ethical doctors** and I'm going to prove that in the coming weeks and months.



**AFFIDAVIT OF HINDISAAR ABDULLAHI**  
**Sworn on November 13, 2024**

I, **Hindisaar Abdullahi**, of the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta, Legal Assistant, SWEAR AND SAY THAT:

1. **I am a legal assistant in the law offices of Field LLP, counsel for the Alberta Health Services ("AHS")**, and as such, have personal knowledge of the matters herein attested to, except where stated to be based upon information and belief, in which case I have stated the source of information and believe the same to be true.
2. Attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit "A"** is a copy of an Order granted by the Honourable Justice Inglis on January 29, 2024 and filed February 14, 2024 (the **"January Order"**).
3. On February 14, 2024, our office served the January Order on the Plaintiffs, Dr. Viliam Makis (**"Makis"**) and Viliam Makis Professional Corporation (**"Makis PC"**) by sending a registered letter attaching the January Order to their address for service. Our office also forwarded a copy of the

**NOTICE TO RESPONDENT(S): DR. VILIAM MAKIS and VILIAM MAKIS PROFESSIONAL CORPORATION**  
This application is made against you. You are a Respondent.  
You have the right to state your side of this matter before the Justice.

To do so, you must be in court when the application is heard as shown below:  
Date: **March 14, 2025 at 10:00 am**  
Where: Edmonton Law Courts Building, 1 Sir Winston Churchill Square  
Before Whom: The Honourable **Justice A. Inglis**, Case Management Justice

Go to the end of this document to see what else you can do and when you must do it.

**Remedy claimed or sought:**

1. An Order:
  - 1) Finding Dr. Viliam Makis [Makis] and Viliam Makis Professional Corporation [Makis PC] in civil contempt of court for breaching the January 29, 2024, Order granted in the within action by this Court [the January Order].
  - 2) That Makis and Makis PC shall, within thirty (30) days:
    - a. Purge their contempt of paragraph 3 of the January Order, requiring them to destroy and permanently delete all patient information in their possession, and swear and file an affidavit confirming they have done so, failing which the within action shall be struck and Makis shall be imprisoned until the contempt is purged.
    - b. Pay the monetary sanction in the amount of \$10,000 imposed by paragraph 5 of the January Order, in default of which Makis shall be imprisoned for a period of eighty-three (83) days and the within action be struck.
    - c. Pay all unpaid cost awards in favor of Alberta Health Services [AHS] arising from the within action, failing which the within action be struck.
  - 3) Awarding costs on an enhanced basis to the Applicant, AHS, of the application giving rise to the January Order, which costs were ordered to be determined at the next appearance.
  - 4) Awarding costs of the within application to AHS on an enhanced basis.
  - 5) Such further and other relief as this Court deems just and appropriate in the circumstances of this case.

**Grounds for making this application:**

2. The January Order was issued because:
  - 1) Makis and Makis PC were in possession of confidential patient information obtained during Makis' former position with AHS, which Makis unlawfully disclosed in contravention of their former contract with AHS and the Health Information Act; and
  - 2) Makis was attempting to commence criminal complaints to police services relating to the matters alleged against the defendants in the within action without leave of the case management justice, in breach of the Order of the Order of the Alberta Court of Appeal filed May 14, 2020, in Court of Appeal File Number 1803-0363 AC
3. The January Order provided that:

5. Dr. Makis is ordered to pay a fine of \$10,000 to the Alberta Treasurer, within 90 days of being served with a filed copy of this Order, which fine may be paid by providing payment and a copy of this Order to the Clerk of the Court.

4. Makis and Makis PC were served with a filed copy of the January Order on February 14, 2014.
5. Makis and Makis PC applied to the Alberta Court of Appeal for permission to appeal the January Order by application filed March 1, 2024, which application was scheduled to be heard July 4, 2024 [Permission Application].
6. By letter dated March 7, 2024, counsel for AHS advised Makis and Makis PC that the time for them to comply with the Order would expire before their Permission Application would be heard, and that they might be found in contempt of the January Order if they did not either comply with its terms or seek a stay of the January Order pending the Permission Application.
7. Makis and Makis PC did not comply with the January Order nor seek or obtain a stay pending the Permission Application at that time or at any time up to the decision of the Court of Appeal.
8. The Permission Application, which was adjourned at the request of Makis, was heard October 10, 2024, and was dismissed by the Court of Appeal with reasons on October 15, 2024.
9. Makis and Makis PC have not complied with the January Order since the dismissal of the Permission Application.
10. The following costs award arising from the within action remain payable to AHS by Makis and Makis PC:

1) \$42,249.20, pursuant to the Bill of Costs of AHS filed herein November 8, 2023; and,

2) \$3,543.75 pursuant to the Order of Slatter J.A. filed October 15, 2024.
