5-Year-Old Dies After Being Misdiagnosed by Doctors Who Said She Had a Cold

Cathy Kassis, 5, was misdiagnosed by doctors as having a common cold, but ended up dying from the bacterial infection Strep A

A family is grappling with the unexpected loss of their 5-year-old daughter.

Justin Sutton, a Bathurst, Australia resident, recounted how his step-daughter, Cathy Kassis, 5, was taken to the doctor's office by her mother, Jasmine Worobez. Doctors said Cathy was suffering from a mere cold and would soon recover.

But medical professionals later realized that Cathy had been afflicted by Strep A, a bacterial strain that initially causes a sore throat, scarlet fever, and skin lesions, as reported by [News.com.au](#).

By the time the infection was identified, it had progressed to a point where Cathy's body had gone into failure, leaving little chance for recovery.

"After three days she had lost her voice completely, so we were obviously a bit concerned," Sutton told [7News](#). "But the doctors just said it was a viral infection and to keep doing what we're doing and let it run its course."

During Cathy's hospital stay, doctors conducted COVID-19 and RSV tests, both of which yielded negative results. Eventually they informed the family that Cathy was grappling with a viral infection and discharged her to return home.

A few days later, on August 28, Cathy's lips reportedly turned blue. Her mother called an ambulance.

"She was going in and out of consciousness and had sort of collapsed in Jazz's arms," Sutton said.

While conversing with emergency services over the phone, Sutton administered CPR for approximately 15 minutes. Shortly thereafter, paramedics arrived.

Cathy was transported by air to Westmead Children's Hospital, where she was declared dead.

"They told us she had been pronounced as brain dead. The coroner found the cause of death was strep A, and Westmead had found that out through a simple throat swab," Sutton said.

[Aug. 2023](#) - Melbourne, Australia - 16 month old Girsirat Kaur had a fever and was assured by family doctor it was nothing. She developed Strep A and spent 2 months fighting for her life including kidney failure, necrosis on her fingertips and was left unable to walk.

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A toddler is lucky to be alive after she spent two months in intensive care battling a deadly infection that a doctor initially misdiagnosed as a fever.

When Melbourne mother Sandeep Kaur took her sick 16-month-old to the GP, she was told her little girl Girsirat had a fever and assured there was no need for concern.

Within three days, Girsirat's condition deteriorated and she was rushed to hospital after her hands, lips and feet turned blue and her skin became discoloured.

Girsirat was diagnosed with strep A and spent the next two months fighting for life in an intensive care unit suffering from various complications, including kidney failure, necrosis on her fingertips and severe swelling which left her unable to walk.

Her experience comes as authorities issue an urgent warning about the infection following an unseasonal spike in severe cases across Australia.

Cases of severe strep A in Aussie children have soared more than 500 per cent since the pandemic and almost claimed Girsirat's life.

Ms Kaur has spoken out about the harrowing ordeal in the hope other parents spot symptoms early and get a second opinion if needed.

'It was terrible, we never expected that,' she told **Seven News**.

'It was a very hard time for us. The GP said it was just a fever she's having.'

Girsirat is still recovering from the life-threatening ordeal.

'It was such a difficult time, our baby had drains in her leg, two operations and required dialysis for 12 days,' Ms Kaur said.

'Thankfully, her fingertips were saved but she is yet to fully recover. I hope that a vaccine can be made for Strep A so no other child has to endure this.'

Strep A can cause severe life-threatening infections including toxic shock syndrome, flesh-eating disease as well as the post-infectious illnesses of acute rheumatic fever, rheumatic heart disease and kidney disease.

Christina Hecktus is living every parent's worst nightmare. Her daughter died suddenly on March 25 of complications of pneumonia and a Strep A infection (iGAS). She was only five years old.

Quintessence Henderson — Quin to her loved ones — "had a smile and a hug and a greeting for anybody," Christina told *Yahoo Canada*.

Earlier this month, Quintessence came down with a "run of the mill" cold. A few days later, she had a fever, but her parents, Christina and Kirk Henderson, were able to bring her temperature down with over-the-counter medication.

Doctors told the Kitchener, Ont. parents their daughter likely had a "secondary cold" and the ER "may not be needed." However, on March 25, Quintessence woke up with a raspy chest and shallow breathing, so they took her to the hospital.

'In my brain, I'm like, we're overreacting'

"It had never occurred to me that she was this sick," Christina said. "I'm thinking they're going to treat her with something for dehydration and maybe give her a puffer for her cough; nothing too serious. We're overreacting. In my brain, I'm like, we're overreacting."

At the hospital, Quintessence took a turn for the worse and was diagnosed with pneumonia and sepsis. Her pediatrician gave her a 50/50 chance of survival.

Within 12 hours of going to the hospital, Quintessence passed away.

Hi everyone, so is this go fund me is for my beautiful cousin Aiyla and her mummy Euly. Aiyla was rushed to St Mary's Hospital on the 25th March 2023 critically ill & needing life saving support, after suffering from a severe case of Strep A. The disease took over her whole body causing sepsis shock, tonsillitis, pneumonia and organ failure to many of her organs. When Aiyla was brought into St Mary's Hospital by Hillingdon Hospital the nurses and consultants didn't think Aiyla was going to survive, they worked from 3am until 4pm the next day to stabilise Aiyla and keep her with us. After spending weeks on the intensive care ward Aiyla became stable. This is where we learnt about the life changing situation aiyla was to face. On the 9th May 2023 - 6 weeks after Aiyla was first admitted to hospital, Aiyla had her first surgery to amputate both legs through the knees and multiple fingers. Since then Aiyla has had 3 more surgeries and has 1 more before she can fully start her recovery process. After suffering with Strep A, sepsis shock syndrome Aiylas body immediately began to shut down causing the blood vessels to stop the blood flow in her less vital organs such as her arms, fingers, legs and toes and save her main organs such as her heart & brain.

On March 2, 2023, [Nevaeh Muley](#) was a healthy and happy two-year-old who was "full of funny faces" and "loved to colour." On March 3, she came down with a fever. On March 4, Nevaeh went into cardiac arrest and died of a Strep A bacterial infection.

"Nevaeh is heaven backwards; it's ironic, you know?" Her father, Eric Muley, told *Yahoo Canada*.

"She was coherent the day before. It didn't make sense; it still doesn't make sense."

A week before the Hamilton, Ont. toddler died, Nevaeh's three older siblings each had a cold and "they all got better."

When it was Nevaeh's turn for the bug, "we just thought, 'OK, you're next.' Everyone else was sick; everyone else got better," Eric said.



[Feb. 28, 2023](#) – Woolloongabba, QLD, Australia – 2 year old Nicole Williams was a very bright, very happy and very healthy 2 year old. She caught influenza with usual symptoms but rapidly deteriorated and was taken to hospital where she suffered cardiac arrest, spent 2 days in ICU and died from complications of Strep A Sepsis.

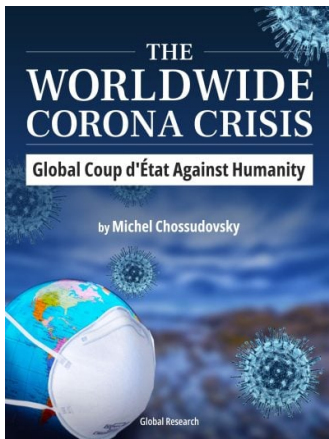
