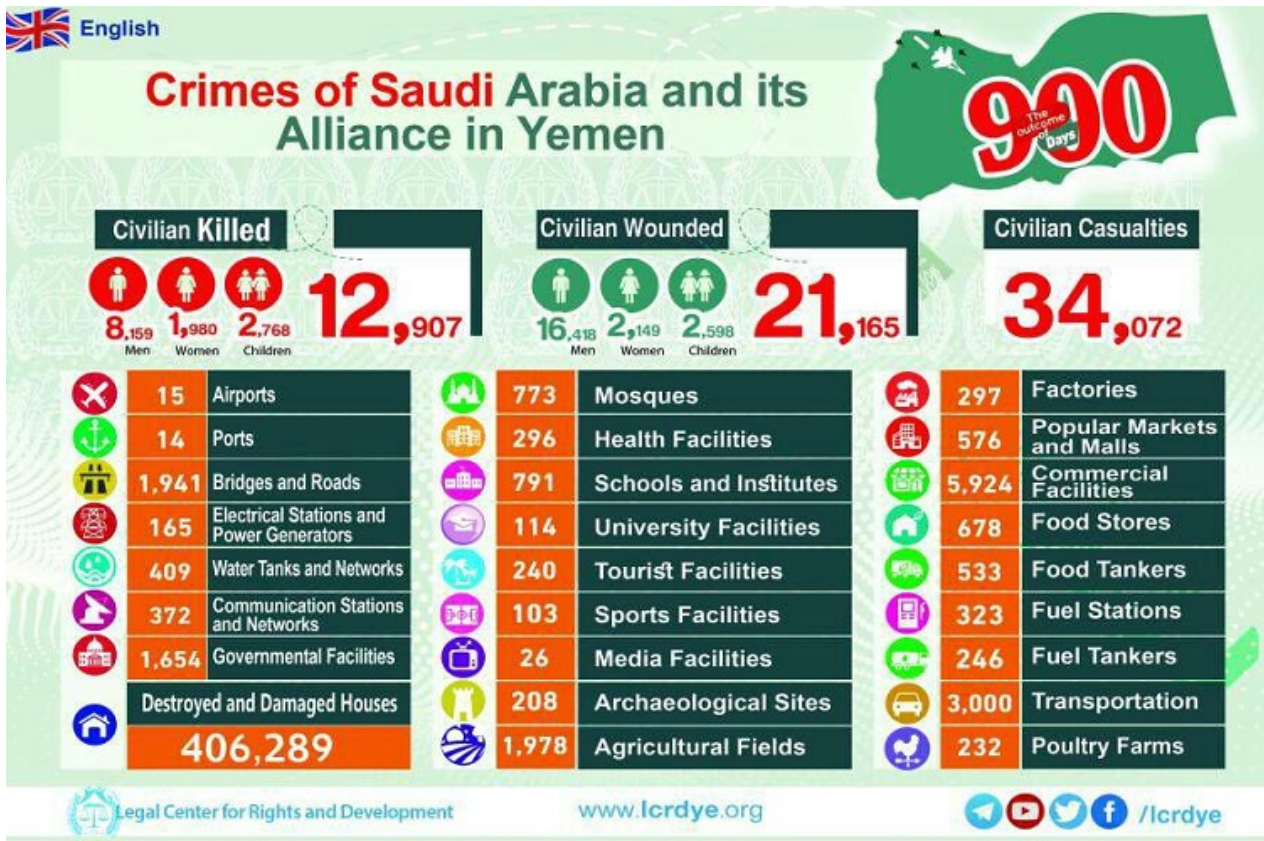

Saudi Arabia declared war against Yemen in 2015 with the aid and support of several other countries through the sale of weapons, logistics and intelligence services.

Below is the summary of casualties and damages, 900 days from the outset of the war, provided by the Legal Center for Rights and Development, a civil society organization based in the capital of Sana'a, Yemen.

- Sa'ada:(5airstrikes + 70 shells)

- (25) Saudi missile bombardment targeted civilians› houses that destroyed (2) houses and damaged (14) others, (2) farms in different areas in Manbah district.
- (15) Saudi missile bombardment targeted civilians› farms that destroyed (1) farm and injured another, (1) water pump in Al Al_Shaikh area, Manbah district.
- (12) Saudi missile bombardment targeted civilians› farms that destroyed (1) and killed livestock in Al Omar area, Manbah district.
- (18) Saudi missile bombardment targeted Al_Ghour area, Ghamr district.
- (3) Airstrikes targeted Al_Hosamah area, Al_Dhaheer district.
- (2) Airstrikes targeted Al_Malaheedh area, Al_Dhaheer district.

• Sana'a:(3airstrikes)

- (3) Airstrikes targeted Nihm district.

• Hajja:(20 airstrike)

- (11) Airstrikes targeted different areas in Meedi district.
- (9) Airstrikes targeted different areas in Haradh district

• Taiz :(3 airstrikes)

- Killed (5) civilians including (3) children, injured (6) others by (1) airstrike targeted a park in Al_Aroos Mountain, Saber district.
- Killed (7) civilians, injured (9) others by (1) airstrike targeted location belonging to the Saudi coalition that destroyed (8) cars in Al_Aroos Mountain, Saber district.
- (1) Airstrike targeted a radio transmitters for Al_Watan local radio that destroyed it in Al_Aroos Mountain, Saber district.

• Sana'a capital:(3 airstrikes)

- (3) Airstrikes targeting the navigational guidance system that destroyed it in Sana'a International Airport, Bani Al_Harith district.
