This drops Laxalt's statewide lead from 9k to about 800 votes.

Laxalt's confidence was gone today — as he realized that Democrats have no problem posting *literally unbelievable vote margins* in order to win.




would be victorious in his race against Mark Kelly — because he too believed that the remaining 500,000 votes to be counted there *heavily favored him*.
