July 28, 2023 – Two Albertans, ages 34 and 35, Jonah Swen and Greg Gaudette were found dead after going missing during a hike along North York Creek Plane Crash Trail outside of Coleman. The were both fully COVID-19 vaccinated PARAMEDICS (<u>click here</u>).

## Alberta hikers found dead in Crowsnest Pass near Coleman





Two hikers who went missing in southwest Alberta have been found dead.

RCMP say they were notified that the two men, aged 34 and 35, were overdue at 10 p.m. on Wednesday.

The pair had been hiking along North York Creek Plane Crash Trail, located outside of Coleman.

RCMP assisted in a search for the pair that included an aerial investigation.

On Thursday at 7 p.m., search and rescue teams located the men deceased at the bottom of a ridge at Mount Coulthard.

One of the victims was Calgary resident Jonah Swen while the other, Greg Gaudette, lived in Lethbridge. Both were paramedics.

# Woman who died during hiking trip remembered for adventurous, selfless spirit

LAS VEGAS (FOX5/Gray News) - Thirty-four-year-old Jessica Rosalie Rhodes was one of two women found dead in Nevada's Valley of Fire State Park after going missing from a hiking trip on July 22.

The temperature in the park that day reached a high of approximately 113 degrees.


"It could've happened to any of us, doesn't matter how good of shape you're in, how prepared you are," said Julie Johnston, Jessica Rhodes' friend and owner of Camp Rhino, where she regularly exercised. "Nobody really knows what actually happened, but nobody could've been in better shape or more prepared to do something like that."

Jessica Rhodes and 29-year-old Diana Matienzo Rivera were found separated, one on the trails and the other in a canyon. They were first reported missing by another group of hikers.

Her mother, Josephine Rhodes, said she believes her daughter was trying to help her friend.

"They were trying to get back, but they just didn't make it and she didn't want to leave her friend down there, so she tried to help her friend," Josephine Rhodes said. "And that's just the type of child she is."

July 18, 2023 – 27 year old former MSU Baseball player Matt Byars "fell" while hiking at Rock Park outside of Denver (<u>click here</u>).



July 17, 2023 – 16 year old Simon Mirkes was on a Camp Tamarack hiking trip in Alaska for Jewish families & children. 3.7 miles into the Harding Icefield trail outside of Seward in Kenai Fjords National Park he collapsed, paramedics from LifeMed helicopter attempted to resuscitate him with CPR but he died on the trail of cardiac arrest (click here).

## Teen hiker dies while hiking on Kenai Peninsula

A 15-year-old died in Kenai Fjords National Park Monday afternoon while hiking the Harding Icefield trail outside of Seward, according to park officials.


A statement from the national park says the young hiker needed emergency medical services and CPR about 3.7 miles into the trail. It says bystanders helped to provide CPR, and paramedics from a LifeMed helicopter attempted to resuscitate the hiker, but were unsuccessful, and he died on the trail of cardiac arrest.

According to the park, agencies including Alaska State Troopers, Alaska Wildlife Troopers, the Bear Creek Fire Department, Seward Volunteer Ambulance Corps and LifeMed Alaska all responded.

The statement does not say why the hiker collapsed or needed CPR. Troopers said the body

# 28-year-old Vermont woman falls to her death while hiking in B.C.



A 28-year-old woman is dead after officials say she fell while on a "technical and advanced-level hike" near Whistler, B.C.

Nicole Killian of Richmond, Vt. dropped down the "chimney" portion of the Black Tusk area in Garibaldi Provincial Park around 11:15 a.m. on Monday, Sea to Sky RCMP said in a statement the following day.

After the fall was reported, Mounties say members of its Whistler unit, RCMP Air Services, BC Ambulance paramedics and Whistler Search and Rescue responded to the area to provide medical aid, but weren't able to save the hiker's life.

Killian is being remembered as a "rescuer of dogs and people alike," according to a statement from her family that was provided by police.

It explains that the 28-year-old had just earned a doctorate in nursing from New York University and was a member of her local search and rescue team.

While Killian was an experienced hiker, B.C. officials are warning backcountry enthusiasts that the Black Tusk chimney and scree portion can be extremely dangerous, even for seasoned mountaineers.

June 26, 2023 – Texas – 14 year old boy fell ill and died unexpectedly during hike while his 31 year old stepdad died while trying to get him help. (<u>click here</u>)

June 24, 2023 – The remains of 65 year old British actor Julian Sands were discovered on a mountainside in Mount Baldy, California. He died while he was hiking. Autopsy could not

determine what caused his death (click here).

A public information officer for the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department confirmed that the cause of death of famous actor Julian Sands has been deemed "undetermined," People reported.


The officer said the death was ruled "undetermined due to the condition of the body and this is common when dealing with cases of this type," according to People.

Recreational hikers discovered human remains on the mountainside on June 24. The remains were confirmed to be those of Sands on June 27. Sands was reported missing in January, after failing to return home after hiking in California's Mount Baldy, which is known for its dangerous terrain, according to People.

The manner of Sands' death was unclear at the time his body was located, and the autopsy failed to provide conclusive information about what precisely led to the British actor's death.

Sands was a highly experienced hiker who had a passion for pushing himself to new levels. He spoke of his love for hiking during a 2020 interview with The Guardian, and thanked his parents for supporting his activities.

May 7, 2023 – 20 year old Clarissa Nicholls from London, UK, died suddenly from cardiac arrest while hiking in France.



April 29, 2023 – 25 year old Eli James Olson died in a "tragic hiking accident on El Capitan mountain in Texas" (<u>click here</u>).

April 26, 2023 – 37 year old NBC News Correspondent Morgan Chesky developed shortness of breath while hiking in Zion National Park. He almost died after developing "high altitude pulmonary edema". He had done tougher hikes before and never had it. (click here)





NBC News correspondent **Morgan Chesky** opened up about the scary and surreal experience he had while hiking in Zion National Park earlier this week.

On Wednesday, Chesky, 37, revealed he was admitted to nearby Cedar City Hospital after suffering a medical emergency in the famed Utah park.

In a statement shared alongside a series of photos, Chesky detailed his experience recovering from <u>high altitude pulmonary edema</u>, when fluid builds up in the lungs and prevents oxygen from moving around your body. He said the incident occurred less than 24 hours after he began his "painstakingly planned" trip.

Feb. 21, 2023 – 41 year old Irish paramedic working in Australia, Fiona Lavelle went missing and was found dead on a hike in Cape Le Grand National Park, Western Australia (<u>click</u> <u>here</u>).



Sep. 2022 – 32 year old doctor and Neurology Resident Dr.Evan Dishion died suddenly while hiking hear Cave Creek, Arizona (<u>click here</u>).

**CAVE CREEK, AZ (3TV/CBS 5)** -- Earlier this week, firefighters say a doctor died from heat stroke while hiking near Cave Creek. Now, his wife is remembering her husband and warning others about hiking in extreme heat. The 32-year-old doctor, Evan Dishion, leaves behind his wife and baby girl.

The Dishion's just had their baby girl, Chloe, three months ago and have been married for eight years. On Monday, Evan went on a hike, which turned into Amy Dishion's worst nightmare. "He promised me he would turn around if it got too hot. I don't know why he didn't," Amy said.

Now, Amy sits with her three-month-old girl, not knowing what their future looks like. Amy says her husband was hiking at Spur Cross Trailhead with a group of friends. Unfortunately, they got lost and ran out of water before calling 911. "I can guarantee you that if there's one last sip of water left, Evan will not be the one to drink it. He's going to make sure other people are OK," Amy said.

Mellencamp Arroyave, former athlete Marcellus Wiley and his family, radio host Ellen K and more are all mourning the loss of Dr. Jay Goldberg.

The OBGYN, who made an appearance on the *Real Housewives*, died of a heart attack while on a hiking trail on May 29, according to the Los Angeles County Medical Examiner-Coroner's Office. He was 53 and suffered from coronary artery disease and high cholesterol, which also contributed to his death, the records show. Goldberg was hiking Will Rogers State Historic Park in Pacific Palisades, Calif., CBS News reported, citing authorities.

In a moving Instagram post, Mellencamp paid tribute to the late physician, who delivered her children—Slate, 9, Cruz, 8, and Dove, 2.


The risk of myocarditis post COVID-19 vaccination is about 1 in 30 and the risk of sudden cardiac death with these activities is simply much too high.
