

June 21, 2023 – Bayville, NJ – 34 year old firefighter Brian Letrent died suddenly from a heart attack. The day before he participated in mandatory full scale training/drill. He collapsed the following day while returning home from work with a cardiac emergency and died in Bayshore Medical Center.

ST PAUL, Minn. — Fire Station 22 was draped in black and purple mourning bunting Monday, as colleagues marked the sudden loss of Captain Chris Parsons.

The veteran firefighter and worker safety advocate died June 15, six days after collapsing on his way home from running a 5K race in Minneapolis. He was only 48.

"Chris was a champion. He was resilient. He wouldn't give up," said Captain Mike Smith, who heads the IAFF Local 21, the Saint Paul firefighters union. Smith said he was stunned to learn that his mentor had died without any warning.

"This hit hard. We're all devastated. It's hard to swallow, hard to digest. A healthy 48-year-old fire captain, a guy who ran twice a day, who ran marathons," Smith remarked.

"He was larger than life. Six feet seven. Everybody knew him. The former president of the statewide firefighters' organization. Now he's just gone."

June 10, 2023 – Vermilion, OH – 50 year old firefighter William John McCale died suddenly of an apparent heart attack. He had undergone stress testing 4 days earlier.



Minnesota led the way on issues of firefighter safety.

He was born June 20, 1972 in Lorain and had been a life long Vermilion resident

Bill worked as a Sheet Metal Worker for Avon Lake Sheet Metal for the past 23 years. He was also the Chief Engineer for the City of Vermilion Fire Department for 12 years before joining the Vermilion Township Fire Department

He was a member of St. Mary Catholic Parish, Vermilion and Local 33 Sheet Metal Workers. Bill was an avid sports fan and enjoyed watching Ohio State football and the Cleveland Browns and Cleveland Indians/Gurdians. He was also a NASCAR enthusiast. Bill also enjoyed barbeques with friends and family, spending time with his dogs, and fixing and remodeling houses. He especially enjoyed spending time with his family.

He is survived by his wife of 26 years, Stephanie (nee Stafford) McCale of Vermilion; daughter, Isabelle "Izzy" McCale of Columbus; son, Tyler McCale at home; mother, Jeanne Marie (nee Kissel) McCale of Vermilion; sister, Colleen (Charlie Grisel) McCale of Vermilion; brother, Gregory (Suzie) McCale of Grove City; and several nephews.

He was preceded in death by his father, William Francis McCale.

It is with deep sadness and heavy hearts that we share the devastating news of the sudden passing of Ray Sawada. At age 38, Ray passed away on the evening of Monday April 10, 2023, while playing the game he loved. He leaves behind his loving wife, Nicole, his two young and incredibly amazing daughters, Victoria (9) and Charlotte (6), and his supportive, devoted, and dedicated family and friends.

Feb. 11, 2023 - Edmonton, AB - 41 year old firefighter **Chris Kinsella** died suddenly, off duty from a "medical event". **He was quadruple vaccinated (double boosted), and died suddenly from a cardiac arrest while he was participating in a cross-country ski race.**



Feb. 3, 2023 – Oregon – 41 year old former Navy Seal and Firefighter Brandon Norbury went into cardiac arrest right after training and died (<u>click here</u>)(<u>click here</u>).



The last day of Brandon Norbury's life began when he clocked in at 7 a.m. for a 24-hour shift at Station 31.

Norbury, a Gresham firefighter for 15 years, had reported for a new assignment that morning, Feb. 3. Station 31, which is near the Portland-Gresham border and responds to calls in both cities, is one of the busiest in the metro area, and Norbury felt like he was coming home. He had worked at the station a decade earlier.

He was ready to get to work. With his background, he easily could have bragged – he was a former Navy SEAL who'd survived multiple overseas missions, then spent eight years as a Gresham police officer. But Norbury's motto was simple: Do, don't talk.

He turned to firefighting because he'd had enough of confrontations, he told friends. Norbury, who was single and had a daughter, wanted a job that only involved helping others.

His new assignment landed him on Engine 31. He was familiar with the rig, but rules required him to take a refresher course called hose evolution. That meant practicing taking hoses off the rig, hooking them to a hydrant and then attaching the other ends to the engine. Over and over he drilled that morning, speed and efficiency with his team being paramount.

When the training ended, Norbury stowed the hoses. But Norbury suddenly wasn't feeling well. He took a breather on Engine 31's back bumper.

Without a word he toppled to the pavement, surrounded by firefighters and paramedics. He was rushed to a nearby hospital, where he was pronounced dead. The official cause: cardiac arrest.

Within the insular world of firefighting, word spread quickly.

Jan. 22, 2023 – Vernon, BC – 50 year old firefighter David Hentschel died suddenly and unexpectedly.

Jan. 12, 2023 - Sequim, WA - 46 yo **firefighter** Capt. Charles "Chad" Cate died in his sleep on Jan. 12, 2023. He was found dead in his bunk by his crew at 7am.

A 46-year-old Washington fire captain was found dead in his bunk hours after responding to a call, officials said.

Charles "Chad" <u>Cate was found dead by his crew members</u> around 7 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 12, the Clallam County Fire District 3 said in a Facebook post.

He had responded to a fire activation call at a commercial building at around 2:25 a.m., the department said.

Then he texted another captain and duty chief around 4 a.m. that all was well at a scene from an earlier house fire, the <u>U.S. Fire Administration</u> said.

When he got back to the station, everyone went to sleep, the fire department said. But Cate didn't wake up in the morning.

Dec. 14, 2022 – Lakewood, WA – 45 year old firefighter and US Army Veteran John Martin Garner died suddenly on Dec. 14, 2022 He died from "heart issues after intensive water rescue training."

"John's public service started in the military, where he served in the Army as a Sergeant earning several ribbons and medals.


