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[July 30, 2023](#) (above) - Federal Way, WA - 24 year old Vitaliy Motso ended up in emergency room in critical condition with whole body sepsis and organ failure on July 28, and died on July 30.

July 27, 2023 - 41 year old German doctor anesthesiologist Dr. Klaus Ott, was on vacation in Croatia when he developed sepsis and died suddenly within 12 hours of getting to the hospital.

Summer in Croatia for a German doctor ended fatally. Namely, at the age of only 41, the father of two died suddenly.

Dr. **Klaus Ott** (41), an anesthesiology doctor at the University Hospital of Augsburg, lost his life from blood poisoning, [writes Fenix Magazine](#).

For his wife **Martin** and their two daughters **Luis** (8) i **Paul** (5) his death came suddenly.

"S dr. Otto loses a great colleague and doctor, who has always been concerned about the well-being of patients and employees", they said from Augsburg University Hospital about the doctor's death.

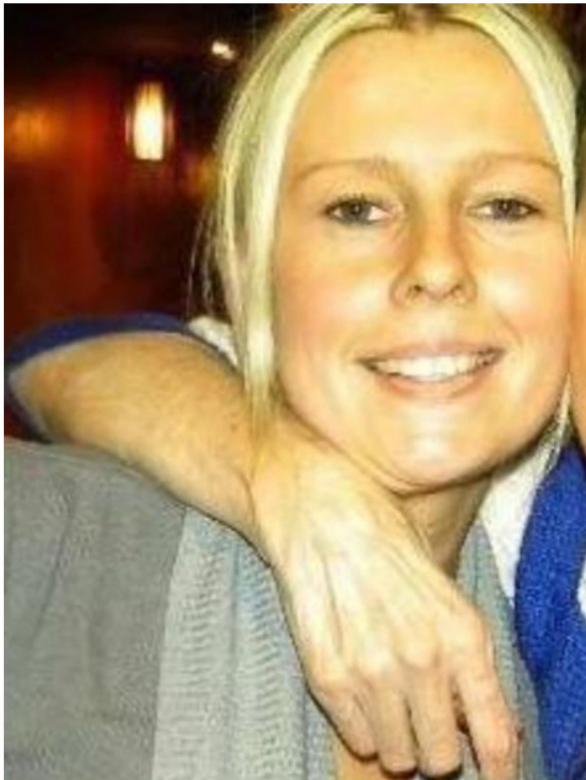
Shortly after arriving at a holiday destination in early June, Dr. Ott told his brother he had all the symptoms of a cold. His brother informed the public about the tragic case **Hartmut Ott**. As he felt worse, he went to the hospital: there he was diagnosed with streptococcus.

The bacterium reached the bloodstream and caused the organ to be canceled to the 41-year-old within a few hours.

Any help arrived too late: a doctor from Augsburg was dead twelve hours after arriving at the hospital.

A relaxing summer vacation with the family turned into a nightmare, the victim's brother claims.

June 30, 2023 - Queensland, Australia - 40 year old Amanda Snell died suddenly on June 30, 2023 while on holiday with her daughter. She developed sepsis & died.

A loving mum has been remembered as a “beautiful soul” after she tragically died while on holiday in Queensland.

Amanda Snell died on June 30 while on a trip with her daughter.

The 40-year-old single mum-of-two had just spent a month in hospital before deciding to visit her brother up in Queensland for an extended holiday.

The interstate trip was meant to be a relaxing time to help the mum “rest and recover” after being unwell.

But tragically, she became “gravely ill” during the holiday and had to return to hospital, where she sadly died from a blood infection.

“Amanda and her young daughter Matilda had very recently gone to Queensland to stay with her brother Michael for an extended holiday, to rest and recover after becoming unwell and spending almost a month in hospital.

“While Amanda was holidaying, resting and recovering, she became unwell again and was admitted to hospital where she became gravely ill from a super bug in her blood.

“Her body wasn’t strong enough to fight it.

Back in February, Ed got really sick. After an ambulance ride and multiple tests, blood cultures revealed he had sepsis. The advanced stage of the infection caused him to quickly go into septic shock and he had to be transferred to Montrose for an extended ICU stay.

A few months later, Ed was sick again. This time he was transferred to Grand Junction where he had to stay for multiple days and found out the bacteria was affecting and perhaps housed in some of his peritoneal organs. After several days of advanced antibiotic care, Ed was sent home, taking extra precautions to stay healthy. They believed the infection was clear but multiple bouts of sepsis had started to take a toll on his system.

As of Father's Day, Ed is currently back in the hospital in Gunnison with yet another bout of sepsis and will need to follow up with specialists so that they can try to get this recurring infection under control. Blood cultures continue to show systemic E. coli and MRI results are pointing towards a prostate infection as the cause.

Only to be miss treated and dismissed as though I was nothing. After 3 subsequent trips to the ETC within a one week time frame they finally decided to admit me. Deesh's Sepsis Journey

Hello, I'm Khedidja, but you might know me as Deesh/Deesha. Life has thrown me a curveball that I never saw coming, and I'm reaching out to share my story with you.

Five months ago, on the 12th April 2023, I welcomed two beautiful twins into the world, naturally with only gas & air. As much as it was a long labour I remember the joy of it going well & being over. I was so happy I said to my partner "I did it", we were in complete awe, our babies were perfect & we went home the next day to introduce them to their big siblings and family, but little did I know that this joyous moment would quickly turn into a life-altering journey.

Shortly after arriving home, I started to get some stomach pains & as days went on it worsened. Despite my concerns, medical professionals initially dismissed my symptoms. It wasn't until April 17th, when I made a desperate call for an ambulance, as my symptoms worsened this includes green/yellow vomit like soap, diarrhoea, body aches, shivering, lost of appetite & on a whole feeling like I was going to die. Ambulance services collected me from my home and I found myself in the care of St George's Hospital, and haven't been home since.

I had battled a infection called Strep A which made my body go into septic shock. My body fought really hard, and I miraculously survived, after having multiple surgeries but Ive been left with profound challenges.

My last memory was in ICU in the early hours of the 18th April 2023. I was told needed a procedure done ASAP. My heart rate was high and blood pressure was very low. I waved my family goodbye and went off to theatre, the last words I remember saying to myself was "I got this". I woke up thinking I had just had my procedure. My partner then began telling me how happy he was I was awake & that I had been sleeping for a whole week in a induced coma, him & my family were told to prepare for the worst. I thought it was a joke he



A family has urged people to be on the lookout for signs of **sepsis** after a young woman died of the condition weeks after she developed flu-like symptoms.

Bethannie Booth, 24, from Merthyr Tydfil, Wales, called NHS 111 after noticing red bumps on her face and was told it was likely to be acne.



However, after she started to develop a sore throat and other symptoms associated with flu she visited the Royal Glamorgan Hospital in Llantrisant, Rhondda Cynon Taf on 5 March, where she was told she had strep A and a collapsed lung, before developing sepsis.

Shortly after, she developed sepsis, which occurs when the body responds poorly to a

Father sues Utah boarding school for malpractice after daughter's death

The father of a teenage girl who died at a boarding school in Utah is suing the facility, which he alleges ignored his daughter's severe pain weeks before her death. FOX 13 Salt Lake City reports.

A 17-year-old student at a "[therapeutic boarding school](#)" in Utah died of sepsis after school staff ignored her health complaints, according to recent autopsy results and a lawsuit filed on behalf of the deceased student and her family.

Taylor Goodridge died of peritonitis, an infection of abdomen tissue, followed by sepsis, which caused her organs to fail, in December 2022 at [Diamond Ranch Academy](#) in Utah.

"It's something that's easily treated with antibiotics, especially with a healthy 17-year-old," attorney Alan W. Mortensen of Mortensen and Milne told Fox News Digital. "The first signs of peritonitis are vomiting and stomach cramps, both of which Taylor had for... at least two-and-a-half weeks before she died. She was never taken to the hospital. Her complaints were ignored, and she was punished for making the complaints."

The infection eventually spread to her heart, liver, kidney and pancreas, said Mortensen, citing the Utah Medical Examiner's autopsy results.

Sep. 10, 2022 - TEEN DEATH Italy - 18 year old Lorenzo Squillace, who was a lifeguard from San Benedetto del Tronto, died suddenly on Sep.10, 2022 after feeling ill at home. He died of sepsis.

THE first results of the autopsy ordered on the body of Lorenzo Squillace, the healthy young lifeguard from San Benedetto del Tronto in Italy who died suddenly at the age of 18, have been made available to Italian media outlets.

UPDATE 5.08 pm (September 15) – Following the death of the lifeguard from San Benedetto del Tronto, who died suddenly on Saturday, September 10, an autopsy was ordered by the public prosecutor's office.

According to the first results of the autopsy examination, Mr Squillace appears to have had a blood infection which, as the forensic doctors confirmed, was realised too late, as reported by [bigodino.it](https://www.bigodino.it) on Thursday, September 15.

Aug. 29, 2022 – New York – 32 year old actress Charlbi Dean died suddenly on Aug.29, 2022. Cause of death was given as “bacterial sepsis”.



CAUSE OF DEATH CONFIRMED
ACTRESS CHARLBI DEAN DIED FROM BACTERIAL SEPSIS

Days after she died, Dean's brother Alex Jacobs told *Rolling Stone* that her sudden death in New York City on Monday happened after she began experiencing "minor" symptoms and soon asked her fiancé, Luke Volker, to take her to an emergency room. She died just hours later.

"This happened literally within the span of a day: getting a headache, going to sleep, waking up her boyfriend and saying please take me to the hospital," Jacobs told *Rolling Stone*.

"We still aren't entirely sure [what happened]," Jacobs added at the time. "There's an autopsy being done which we know might take quite a while. But what we have heard [that] there was a viral infection in her lungs."

Jacobs told *Rolling Stone* that Dean was involved in a "very, very bad car accident" around 2009, after which doctors removed her spleen. She also suffered broken ribs and a broken back in the accident, according to her brother.

"[The spleen is] involved in fighting off infections, and that could have had something to do with what happened," Jacobs said. "Her spleen not being there just added on to the reason why she perhaps couldn't fight it off."

Charlbi Dean's cause of death has been determined by a New York City Medical Examiner.

The *Triangle of Sadness* actress -- whose full name is Charlbi Dean Kriek -- died from an unexpected and sudden illness in August. She was 32.

At the time, the illness was not revealed.

A spokesperson for the New York City Office of Chief Medical Examiner confirmed to PEOPLE on Wednesday that she died of bacterial sepsis.

[Aug. 22, 2022](#) - 48 year old Keith Carrington, beloved Principal at North Division High School and Security Guard for the Milwaukee Bucks, died suddenly of sepsis while recovering from foot surgery.

MILWAUKEE (CBS 58) -- A Milwaukee widow told CBS 58 her husband's death will be investigated by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) nearly six months after he died unexpectedly at Ascension Columbia St. Mary's Hospital.

"I believe that my husband paid the ultimate price, which was his life, in his visit to Columbia St. Mary's," Tanzanique Carrington said.

Keith Carrington, [a beloved principal at North Division High School and a security guard for the Milwaukee Bucks at Fiserv Forum](#), died in August 2022 while recovering from surgery.

"Keith was an extraordinary guy," Tanzanique Carrington said. "We just had such an outpouring of love from the community after he passed away because it was so sudden that people just couldn't believe it."

Carrington told CBS 58 she decided to file a complaint with DHS after reading investigative journalism reports on issues within the hospital where her husband died, the same issues she said she noticed during their time in Ascension's care.

"I knew something was not right," Carrington said.

Carrington said her husband was admitted to Ascension Columbia St. Mary's Hospital in August for foot surgery by recommendation of a podiatrist.

"There were red flags from the time that Keith actually entered the emergency room at the hospital," Carrington said.

Carrington said the hospital appeared to be short-staffed and she felt parts of her husband's treatment went overlooked.

She told CBS 58 the surgery went well, but problems persisted in his post-operative care.

On the day Keith Carrington died, Tanzanique Carrington said he was feeling a fever coming on, but otherwise appeared to be recovering well.

Carrington said she got her husband up to use the restroom and when he came out, he was having trouble breathing. His heart stopped minutes later.

Tanzanique Carrington said her husband's death certificate lists his cause of death as septic shock.

Carrington said she believes the health care professionals at Ascension Columbia St. Mary's Hospital missed the warning signs of the fatal condition.

Carrington told CBS 58 DHS responded to her complaint on Friday, letting her know an investigation would be initiated.

"It kind of validated my feeling that something was off," Carrington said.

My Take...

COVID-19 mRNA vaccines severely damage the immune system.

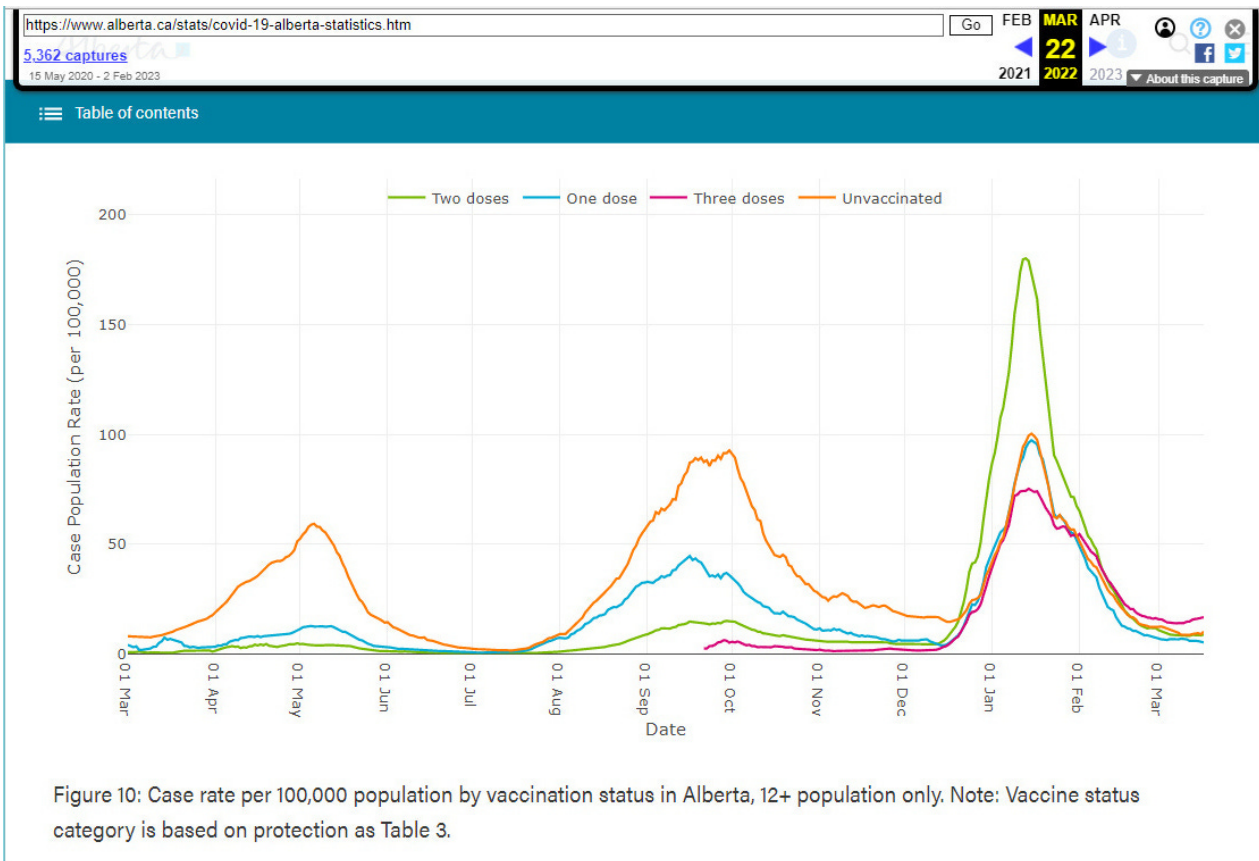
This is why the vaccinated are constantly getting sick - they're getting re-infected with COVID-19, they're repeatedly coming down with the flu, etc.

On Sep.18, 2023, I made a 3 hour testimony to the NCI (National Citizen's Inquiry) in Canada.

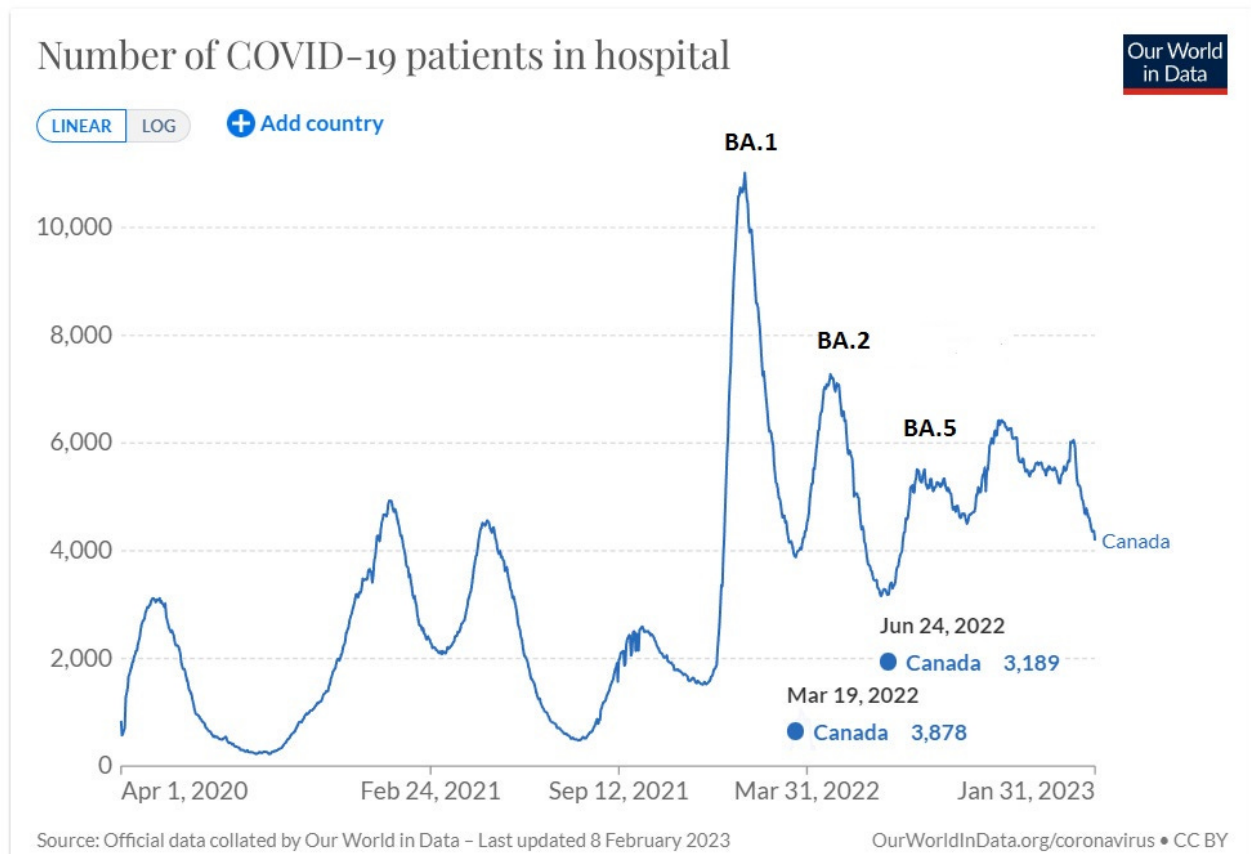
Part of my sworn testimony was about the Alberta government deleting crucial data which showed immune system damage that the double COVID-19 vaccinated were suffering starting in December 2021.

My concerns:

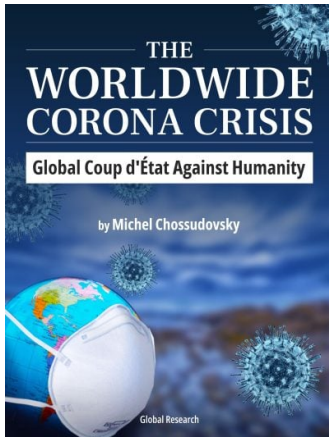
The COVID-19 vaccinated are not being informed by their doctors that their immune systems are being damaged further by each jab.

- COVID-19 vaccinated should consider taking high doses of Vitamin D daily, probably at least 10,000 IU, to improve their immune system.
