

Margot was recently diagnosed with Bulbar Onset ALS, a rapidly advancing form of ALS. In a matter of weeks, she went from living a normal life to having serious difficulty using her hands, speaking, and swallowing.



Former Hamilton College athlete, longtime SUNY Poly coach, official Grimmer dies: 'He's a special person'

NEW HARTFORD — Kevin Grimmer made his mark on the Mohawk Valley as a standout athlete, coach and administrator.

Grimmer, who was a star basketball player at Notre Dame High School in Utica and Hamilton College before transferring his skills to coaching as well as an administrator at SUNY Institute of Technology/SUNY Polytechnic Institute, died Monday. Grimmer, who was 64 years old, had been recently diagnosed with ALS, the rare neurodegenerative condition also known as Lou Gehrig's disease.

Longtime Notre Dame basketball coach Mike Durr said Grimmer was a "lifelong friend" and colleague. They played basketball together through grammar school and high school and later against each other at the college level. They were in each other's weddings, Durr said.

"Obviously, athletics was a huge thing his whole life," Durr said Monday in a telephone interview with the Daily Sentinel after traveling to the Mohawk Valley from out-of-state. "But, I think his legacy is that he always put his family first. His wife and his kids and his grandkids were the world to him."

Nov. 6, 2023 – 72 year old Carl Torbuch, college football coach, died a week after diagnosed with ALS.



When ETSU planned to reinstate football in 2013, Head coach Carl Torbush joined the Buccaneer family. He remained head coach until 2017, when he retired from the coaching profession.


Coach Torbush was a fan of many sports. As an athlete, his favorite was baseball. In his youth, he played with the Kansas City Royals rookie league team for a summer and continued playing baseball all his life.

Torbush passed away on Monday, Nov. 6, at the age of 72.

"Coach Torbush was a classy guy. I knew him for a long time, being from Jefferson City. He actually did his student teaching for my dad at the old Jefferson High School. There wasn't a time that I saw Coach that he didn't talk about how my dad swung the meanest paddle he'd ever seen," shared current head coach George Quarles.

"Coach was one of those guys who loved people and obviously was a great football coach that did it for a long time at a high level. It's a sad day because of the great impact he had on so many people. It was a life well lived for sure."

Torbush was a beloved and well-accomplished coach across all collegiate football. He held coaching positions across multiple universities like Ole Miss, the University of Alabama, Texas A&M, and the University of North Carolina, where he worked his way up the ladders to become head coach for the Tar Heels. Afterward, he came to East Tennessee State University.




Abdel Kharrazi was brought forth into the world on September 20, 1976 and lived 47 years until passing away on October 25, 2023.




