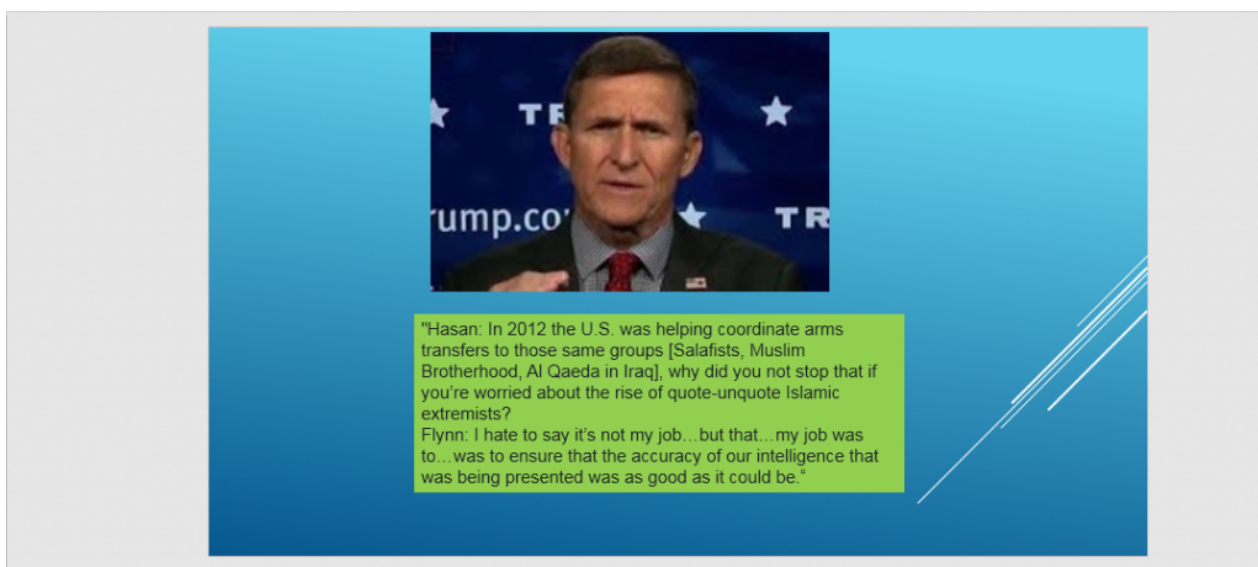

Former U.S Ambassador to Syria, **Robert Ford**, worked closely with the terrorists.

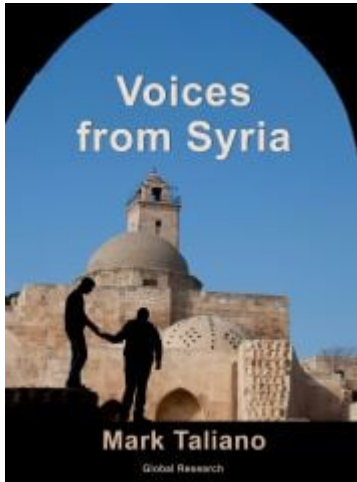
