A talented teenage rugby player with a "contagious charm" has died from a heart attack.

The tightly-knit community of Baltinglass was plunged into sadness this week when news broke that popular local teenager Pauric Brady died on Wednesday night aged just 18, after a short battle with cancer.

The son of Avril and Martin Brady, and older brother of Ronan, Pauric was deeply engrained in the Baltinglass community, leaving an indelible mark on students and faculty at his former school Scoil Chonglais, as well as Baltinglass GAA and BaltinglassTown AFC - with whom Pauric had been a player, coach and cherished friend.

The Bradys's world was flipped upside down last December when they were informed that Pauric, who turned 18 last November, had been diagnosed with a rare form of cancer. After further tests, the devastated family were told that the cancer had spread and was terminal.

A 'fit and healthy' teenager died after going to A&E with what he believed were symptoms of a sinus infection.

Harvey Edwards, 19, moved from Bristol to Liverpool to study at university last year. However on June 6, after feeling unwell, the teenager, who was described as a "fit and healthy person", presented himself to A&E.






It is understood he was **taking antibiotics for a sinus infection**, but when his symptoms continue to worsen he went back to hospital on June 13.

The student was given an MRI scan which is when he was told the devastating news he had a bleed on his brain. In a bid to tackle the bleed, and alleviate pressure on the teenager's brain, he was told he would need to be put in an induced coma.

But, sadly Harvey suffered a devastating stroke and his family had to make the heartbreaking decision to turn off his life support on June 28.

Harvey's cause of death has not yet been confirmed and it is not known whether he was in fact suffering with a sinus infection or whether his symptoms were being caused by the bleed on his brain.

A teenage roller derby star has died after suffering an unexplained cardiac arrest.

Keira Dascoli-Guymer, from Nambour on Queensland's Sunshine Coast, was a perfectly fit and healthy 18-year-old but she suddenly collapsed on June 17.

She was rushed to Sunshine Coast University Hospital and spent 10 days in intensive care in a coma.

Her family on June 27 made the heartbreaking decision to switch off her life support.

Her mother Lisa Guymer said doctors have not determined what caused the teen's heart to stop and the family is now faced with the reality they may never know what happened to her daughter.

'She didn't have a heart attack ... her heart just stopped and they don't know why,' she told the Courier Mail.

'It's hard to try and accept they don't know, and we may never know.'

Mrs Guymer said her daughter was a roller derby fanatic and saw the colourful sport as a place where she truly fit in.

'Roller derby is generally a sport that is full of outcasts and people who have their own unique personalities, and very caring people,' Mrs Guymer said.

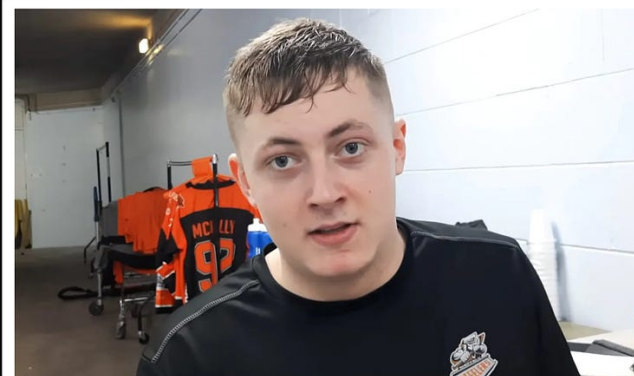
'Once (Keira joined the sport) she finally felt she fit in.'

It was a sport she took up at the start of 2020 after learning how to skate by watching YouTube tutorials.

An apprentice electrician who died three days after he collapsed during a game of Oztag went for regular checkups as his family had a history of heart problems.

Caleb Pace, 20, whose heart went into fibrillation causing him to stop breathing while playing the match at a **Gold Coast** sports ground, may have had a hereditary heart condition.

Onlookers performed CPR on Mr Pace at the touch footy ground and he was rushed to Gold Coast University Hospital, where he was placed in an induced coma.

He died on June 23. The exact cause of Mr Pace's death is not yet known.

The family of a young **Gold Coast** man who died after collapsing while playing Oztag touch footy says he was "checked all the time" for [heart problems](#).

But "[nothing ever came up on the radar](#)" for 20-year-old Caleb Pace before his death this month, his uncle Steve Clarke told 7NEWS.com.au.

Pace was described as fit, healthy and active. As well as playing Oztag, he trained in mixed martial arts and worked as an electrician, Clarke said.

June 18, 2023 - Wales - 19 year old Daniel Smyth collapsed while on family holiday in Bulgaria. He woke in early morning hours feeling ill, collapsed in the bathroom and died. ([Click here](#))

A 19-year-old has collapsed and died on holiday after losing his life to an undiagnosed heart condition. Daniel Smyth was unaware he had a condition but collapsed on a family beach holiday in Bulgaria last week.

A post-mortem examination has now found the student had cardiac arrhythmia, an irregular heartbeat. Daniel's cousin Ellen Devenney-Adams told the [Mirror](#): "He had a heart condition, which he did not know about. It was a ticking time bomb basically because it was inevitable, it just happened to occur when he was on holiday."

Daniel had gone to bed early on Saturday night feeling ill and woke in the early hours. He went into the bathroom, but collapsed, smashing into and breaking part of the toilet, shower door and sink.

This flooded the bathroom and caused a leak in the hotel, which alerted staff.

Ellen, 26, said: "We got a phone call with news about the post-mortem. Doctors found he had this irregular heartbeat, called cardiac arrhythmia.

"He was a fit and healthy 19-year-old boy otherwise. It was just one of those things. His family are heartbroken and gutted. No one saw this coming at all.

"I can't imagine what they (immediate family) are feeling because Daniel was so close to everyone."

June 17, 2023 - Southampton, UK - 13 year old Sydney Daarol died suddenly in her sleep from cardiac arrest on June 17 2023. "She was perfectly healthy and had come home from a fun day of bowling with friends."

A heartbroken family has paid tribute to their "precious son" who died **after collapsing on a playing field at school**.

Joshua Lloyd, 12, was found in a critical condition at Telford Langley **School** on Friday afternoon as onlookers desperately tried to revive him.


He was rushed to the Princess Royal **Hospital** but, despite the efforts of paramedics, died shortly afterwards.

Police are not treating his death as suspicious and said ambulance crews responded to a "medical emergency".

Joshua's relatives have now described their "unimaginable pain".


A **tribute** from his family said: "We gather here today to honour the precious life of our Joshua, a beloved son, brother, grandson, nephew, cousin, and friend who brought endless joy and love to all those around him."

Devastated family, friends and teammates have remembered Myles for his radiant smile and loving, kind nature. The club have named an award in his honour, while a GoFundMe page has so far received hundreds of donations totalling more than £12,000 – including £1,000 from the club.

Tributes have poured in for an Edinburgh teenager who died suddenly while playing football at a city school.

Andrew MacKinnon, 15, collapsed on the pitch  at Forrester High School in the city at around 3.15pm yesterday. Police and ambulance crews attended but despite their efforts, the teenager died at the scene.

My Take...

I started reporting on sudden deaths of Canadian teenagers in November 2022, when I started seeing them on a frighteningly regular basis.

Now we are seeing teenagers die suddenly in all the highly COVID-19 vaccinated countries.

From my observations, this is how COVID-19 vaccines are killing teenagers, from more frequent causes to less:

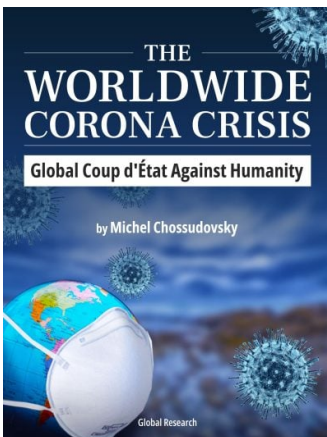
1. Cardiac arrest during intense exercise (most deaths, vaccine myocarditis)
2. Cardiac arrest doing a regular activity
3. Cardiac arrest while sleeping (early morning hours, vaccine myocarditis)
4. Blood clots – strokes (brain clots), pulmonary emboli (lung clots)
5. Brain Bleed (usually a ruptured aneurysm, due to damaged blood vessels)
6. Infections (sepsis, strep, influenza, meningitis – due to damaged immune system)
7. Turbo cancer (most commonly leukemia, lymphoma, brain – glioblastoma)

In this group of 16 teenagers who died recently in UK, Ireland or Australia, you see all of these causes of death represented (except pulmonary emboli).
