Transverse Myelitis (TM) is a rare neurological disorder of the spinal cord, caused by inflammation and occurring across one spinal segment, leading to severe motor, sensory and autonomic dysfunction.

The mechanism of injury is inflammation of the spinal cord causing damage to the myelin sheath of the nerves.

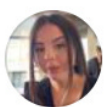

Imagine going to bed one night then waking up completely paralyzed from the neck down. This is what happened to Kayla Pollock. She already fights Type 1 Diabetes every day. Now she is also fighting Acute Transverse Myelitis. A lesion on her spinal cord attacked her nerves in her body leaving her no control of her entire body except slight movement in her hands. She cannot feed or wash herself or go to the washroom. Her condition combined with the diabetes is so severe that she must have someone spend every night with her but who also has to work all day. Friends are taking care of their cat, fish, axolotl, chameleon and very large Great Dane Puppy Fynn.

Doctors believe this condition was caused by taking the Moderna vaccine booster. The risk of getting this is only 1 in 200,000 vaccines but Kayla was at higher risk because she already has an autoimmune condition, Type 1 Diabetes.

As I approach my 24th birthday next week, I have been reflecting on my 20 months of paralysis. Ever since the day I woke up with a mysterious illness (that we now know is Behcet's disease causing Transverse Myelitis which is an autoimmune spinal cord injury) that left me paralyzed from the chest down in November of 2021 I have had so many lows, but also many highs.

I still have a million appointments, infusions, need people to do so many things for me, and many more things that make every day soo hard. However, I was able to go on a cruise, kayaking, and hand cycling all within the month of June which were amazing.

I really didn't think I would ever enjoy my life again during my almost 2 month hospital stay after the initial day I woke up unable to move my legs at all. I have have reset my mindset to live every day to the fullest and I'm thankful my family has also taken this into consideration. I have traveled and had fun days. But, this isn't to say that there aren't LOTS of hard days where I stay in bed all day (because honestly that's what most every day looks like and I only let others see the good).

God works in really weird ways that don't always feel good, but I know he makes all things work together for our good. I have regained even more movement in my legs since my last update and even though this only happens in a gravity eliminated position, it is HUGE in my recovery that there are signals going from my brain through my spinal cord and into my legs!

It's really hard to accept that chronic illness and paralysis are probably always going to be a big part of my life, but my goal in all of this is to not let these things define who I am or what I do.

I have felt so alone in my health journey every day, but realize every person has their own struggle and God uses these visible and invisible struggles for his good if you let him. Every day is hard with paralysis and I'm not going to sugar coat that, but I'm trying to find ways to glorify the Lord and enjoy the time I have been given here on earth because I know that tomorrow isn't guaranteed for any of us.

I'm not afraid of tomorrow because I know God is already there 💜

Hey everyone thanks for accepting me to the group. I'm still getting used to everything but I was diagnosed with TM this past April. I'm currently serving in the Army, and back in March we were "asked" to get the COVID vaccine, and two weeks later I got really sick, that's when everything started. I woke up April 5th with a numbing sensation in my side, and at first thought nothing of it other than I slept wrong. As the day progressed the sensation began to get worse, but again I didn't think anything of it. The following day I woke up and the sensation had spread across my stomach and my back, and it felt like intense pressure, and static. I approached my leadership to let them know I was planning on going to get checked out, but my CO denied my request because we were preparing for a two week long field operation. The entire week I tried to just blow it off, but the the combination of being sick, and the intense numbing sensation made things VERY difficult to perform my day to day duties. That Saturday I woke up and the sensation had completely spread past my waist, and down my legs to my feet. When I finally had a chance to go to the hospital, the doctors told me there was nothing they could do for me, and sent me home on bed rest for a few days, and advised me to return if things changed. I waited three days, but by this point I had lost my ability to walk on my own, and I had lost my sensory nerves so I couldn't feel anything, like touch, heat, cold, and even pain. When I got to the hospital the doctor asked why I had returned, and I explained to them that I wasn't getting better, just worse. They eventually decided to transfer me elsewhere, so I could see a Neurologist, and that is how I ended up getting my diagnosis a couple days later. I spent a month in the hospital receiving steroid, and plasma treatments, which somewhat helped in the sense of giving me strength in my legs, however I now have permanent nerve damage in areas. My sensory system is still off, and now I walk around with a Walker, because my legs feel like jelly. I am seeing an MS specialist this Friday, and I've been doing Physical Therapy every other day. Any advice on how to manage flare ups? I've been getting them a lot lately, nothing as intense as the one that put me in the hospital, but they are extremely uncomfortable.



Covid-19 vaccine trial participant had serious neurological symptoms, but could be discharged today, AstraZeneca CEO says

The participant who triggered a global shutdown of AstraZeneca's Phase 3 Covid-19 vaccine trials was a woman in the United Kingdom who experienced neurological symptoms consistent with a rare but serious spinal inflammatory disorder called transverse myelitis, the drug maker's chief executive, Pascal Soriot, said during a private conference call with investors on Wednesday morning.

The woman's diagnosis has not been confirmed yet, but she is improving and will likely be discharged from the hospital as early as Wednesday, Soriot said.

The board tasked with overseeing the data and safety components of the AstraZeneca clinical trials confirmed that the participant was injected with the company's Covid-19 vaccine and not a placebo, Soriot said on the conference call, which was set up by the investment bank J.P. Morgan.

My Take...

Acute Transverse Myelitis (ATM) used to be a rare neurological condition (1 case / million / year) ([source](#)).

ATM is an inflammatory disorder of the spinal cord that results in motor, sensory and autonomic dysfunction, with relatively severe disability in one third of patients (that's why so many of the patients I've presented are now in a wheelchair).

Roman et al. published a paper in April 2021 implicating COVID-19 infection in causing transverse myelitis but also found 3 ATM patients who took AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccine. Their conclusion is stunning for its time, and that it was even published: ([click here](#)).

"The pathogenesis of ATM remains unknown but it is conceivable that SARS-CoV-2 antigens, perhaps also present in AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccine may induce immune mechanisms leading to the myelitis.

What they are gently referring to is the COVID-19 SPIKE PROTEIN.

A review by Ostovan et al. identified 31 patients with post COVID-19 vaccination transverse myelitis, 17 women and 14 men: ([click here](#))

- 12/31 AstraZeneca
- 8/31 Pfizer
- 7/31 Moderna
- 3/31 Sinopharm
- 1/31 J&J

21/31 had good recovery, and 10/31 had poor recovery (those who remain paralyzed and confined to a wheelchair).

WHO's VigiAccess Database ([click here](#)) has 1300 cases of transverse myelitis reported linked to COVID-19 vaccines. Here is a comparison to other neurological injuries:

- 21,786 Seizures
- 11,723 Bell's Palsy
- 7,693 Guillain-Barre syndrome
- 5,650 brain fog
- 5,413 paralysis
- 2,180 multiple sclerosis
- 1,300 transverse myelitis (linked to COVID-19 vaccines)

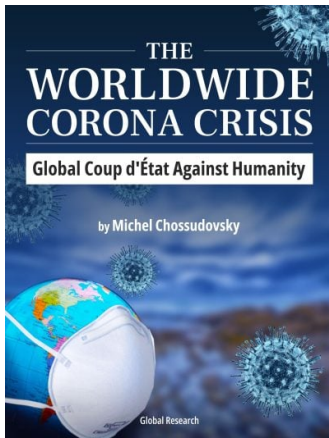
