Oct. 11, 2023 – Grimsby, UK – 14 year old Alana Bee was just diagnosed with a rhabdomyosarcoma of the cervix spreading into the uterus, bladder, bowel, etc.



teenager has described her "devastating" experience of battling a rare form of cancer at the age of just 14.

Alana Bee, from Grimsby, went to the doctors after an unusual period and was told she had a type of cervical cancer called rhabdomyosarcoma. She was diagnosed just weeks after her 14th birthday and almost immediately had surgery to remove one of her ovaries.

Alana and her mum Vanya were left devastated when they were told the news in June before the teenager started a course of chemotherapy in July. However, Alana suffered from heavy bleeding after the first two rounds and had to have multiple transfusions. Sadly, the bleeding continued and she was rushed to Leeds for a total hysterectomy to remove the tumour.

Now at home recovering, she told GrimsbyLive of her "devastating" experience as she prepares for the next round of chemotherapy to ensure the tumour doesn't spread to the rest of the body.

She said: "I went to the doctors in February after having an unusual period and was given antibiotics at first, but nothing changed and I knew something wasn't right. Eventually, I was sent for a biopsy and an MRI which is when they told me I had a tumour on my cervix and into my uterus."

Alana was also told the tumour may have spread to her bladder and bowel. However, when doctors delivered the news, she didn't know what to think. "It was devastating and really sad," said Alana. "I remember just crying and crying and asking if my hair would fall out.



Hello friends! If you're reading this, it's likely you know the beautiful and amazing Brookelle McMullin or someone else that loves her. This young lady and her family need your help and support very much.

About a month ago, Brookelle went into Albany Medical Center for a biopsy on a swollen lymph node in her neck. What we expected to be a routine biopsy, turned into our worst nightmare. Shortly after her surgery, the test results came back saying she had Statge 4 cancer called rhabdomyosarcoma, which is affecting her soft tissues. More tests came and went and those results showed that the cancer had moved to her lymph nodes as well as several places in her bones.

We were lucky to immediately secure a wonderful team of doctors at Albany Med, who built an aggressive but hopeful treatment plan. Brookelle starts chemotherapy on October 20, which will continue for 42 weeks. About halfway through the chemo treatment,



Hello, I'm April and I'm starting this fundraiser to help my sister Panda and her 16 -year-old son Gavin. Gavin was diagnosed with a very rare and aggressive cancer called Rhabdomyosarcoma. My sister Panda is a loving single-mother and a dedicated nurse practitioner who is currently overwhelmed with challenges, both financial and emotional.

Due to the rarity of Gavin's cancer, he has to attend a specialist treatment center at Vanderbilt University Children's Hospital in Nashville. This means they must travel over three hours each way for his weekly chemotherapy treatments. As the treatments begin in early morning and often last more than 8 hours, it means overnight stays.



Kane was diagnosed with Rhabdomyosarcoma back in July 2022. Rhabdomyosarcoma (RMS) is a rare type of Children's cancer.

A truly happy day was on 29th June when Kane rang the bell to symbolise, he had finally finished his gruelling treatment, and we thought his fight was finally over.

He had a well-deserved break to spend some quality time with his nana in Middlesbrough. Things were really starting to look good for kane he was managing to make it around the house on his crutches and had lots more energy. He was really excited for his trip to Disney Paris which was booked for September.

His dad had booked a holiday for them both to Dorset their special place.

However, in August 2023, we got the devastating news that the cancer had returned that he had 3 large tumours on major organs and that he only had weeks left.

Sadly, our precious Kane had just turned 14 when he closed his eyes and went to sleep for the very last time on the 18th of September 2023. Almost 4 weeks after the tragic diagnosis.

Thank you for reading about David's story. My son Tommy and David have been best friends since 6th grade. During the start of that school year, David was given the scariest diagnosis no young child should ever have to hear. What was just thought to be an innocuous bump on his cheek turned out to be an aggressive form of childhood cancer called Rhabdomyosarcoma. Rhabdomyosarcoma is an extremely rare type of cancer that forms in soft tissue — specifically skeletal muscle tissue. At age 12, David went through countless chemotherapy treatments, radiation, and incredibly risky surgery in his battle with this horrible disease. With the love of his family, friends and supremely skilled doctors, surgeons, nurses and medical professionals, he was able to be declared cancer free after these initial grueling treatments.

David was so excited to be starting high school this year when his parents discovered another small lump on his shoulder in March. With the heaviest of hearts, David and his family's worst fears were confirmed with a biopsy indicating that his Rhabdomyosarcoma had returned and metastasized in a very challenging area to treat. He immediately began rounds of chemotherapy, radiation and traveled to Boston to find the very best cancer doctor willing to take David's case on.

<u>Aug. 14, 2023</u> - Champlin, MN - 15 year old Tanner Anderson had abdominal pains in November 2022 and was diagnosed with Rhabdomyosarcoma. He died 9 months later.

Tribute to Tanner Anderson

Tanner's story started on November 12, 2022 - he was complaining of stomach issues and a dull pain in his lower stomach below his waist. They thought it was a bug or something of the sort and encouraged him to drink more water to try to flush whatever it was out of his stomach.

At Children's, they did a CT and ultrasound. The ultrasound confirmed the spot and also another spot near the first one. It also showed thickening of the bladder wall (sometimes means cancer cells), along with most of the lymph nodes in the area being enlarged with one that is very large. The few scans that the CT picked up also showed enlarged lymph nodes on both sides of his chest. Tanner was diagnosed with a cancer called Rhabdomyosarcoma. So, with all of those things combined, he started the fight of his life.

Tanner is only 15 years old. He has spent the last 9 months down at the Mayo clinic or Children's Hospital. He has undergone weeks of Chemotherapy, Radiation and numerous tests. They received the news that there are no more treatments they can offer.


