14 Tragic Cases - First in the World Article

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Oct. 21, 2023 - Clarksville, TN - 40 year old Rayne Williamson died after a 2 year battle with synovial sarcoma which was diagnosed in June 2021 when she was pregnant with twins.

- On March 31, 2021, Rayna did IVF with 2 embryo transplants and started having difficulty breathing
- In June 2021 she was told she was expecting twins, but also told she had a lung mass that was diagnosed a Synovial Sarcoma and was surgically removed
- In Oct. 2021 she was diagnosed with brain metastasis "the size of a racquetball" which was surgically removed Nov. 2, 2021.
- Nov. 29, 2021 she started 6 rounds of chemo
- Dec. 23, 2021 her twins were born
- May 11, 2022 she had lung surgery for a 2nd lung tumor.
- Sep. 6, 2022 she had another new lung mass, surgery Dec. 31, 2022.
- Oct. 30, 2022 she did a 3 week stay in Mexico at an alternative medicine clinic
- March 2023 she had more chemo, radiation ending in May 2023.
- Doctors at MD Anderson said she may have years still to live
- She died on Oct. 21, 2023

Nov. 3, 2023 - Bremen, GA - 30 year old Hannah Hill was diagnosed with a massive sarcoma of the right lung. She has a 5 month old, who seems to be doing fine. She is currently responding to chemo after 1st type of chemo didn't work.

We are Rob and Kristi (friends of Savannah & Heath) and we are asking for help from our family, friends and communities to assist Savannah and Heath through the following journey they have been navigating, very bravely, over the past year and a half:

In November of 2021, Savannah noticed a mass in her side. Through initial doctoring, they discovered a miracle - Savannah was 5 months pregnant with their 3rd child. After more scans, the mass was still in the abdomen and at the time thought to be nothing more than a fibroid. The pregnancy was monitored, and they got a healthy baby boy, Axel on April 20th, 2022.

Post-delivery is when her life forever changed.


A biopsy of the mass, which would only be done after the baby was delivered, came back as a cancerous glomus tumor. A direct referral to Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN soon became the next fight.

On January 10th, 2023, Savannah was diagnosed with Leiomyosarcoma (LMS), which is an extremely rare, soft tissue cancer that accounts for less than 1% of all adult cancers. Unfortunately, there is no cure for this rare cancer. However, Savannah continues to fight each and every day. She continues to care for and mother her and Heath's three beautiful children: Hadley (12), Eason (10) and Axel (15 mos.).

We also had a chance to meet with the radiologist and got some mixed news. The initial radiation on the 3 spots in the brain did work and hit the center of the cell and it showed that the tumors were dying from within. Unfortunately, before the radiation took out the center of the cell, there were some cancer cells that escaped and spread to some different parts of the brain. We also found that there was a recurrence in the abdomen, a new spot in the leg and one in the lower back.

Oct. 1, 2023 - Kansas City, MO - 17 year old Aria Mia Gonzalez had Ewing Sarcoma when she was 13 but she was in remission since. In May 2023, when she was 30 weeks pregnant, she was diagnosed with sarcoma cancer recurrence and died quickly on Oct. 1, 2023.







We are devastated to share the heartbreaking news of the sudden passing of Aria Mia Gonzalez. She was a beloved family member/friend who brought immense joy to those around her. Our real life warrior who overcame so many tough obstacles. At the young age of 13, Mia was diagnosed with Ewing Sarcoma. She went into remission and diagnosed again with cancer May 2023. Mia was 30 weeks pregnant at the time. She gave birth to her daughter and had to go through the challenges of being a young mom and battling cancer again.

Hi, my name is Alan.

I am the father-in-law of a beautiful young woman. She is a loving wife, and a wonderful mother of 2 (ages 1 and 2). 1 year ago, Anna was pregnant with their 2nd child when she started having major headaches and losing vision in her right eye. The ER doctors were ignoring the symptoms and kept sending her home. Finally, after she woke up completely blind in her right eye, the ER doctors agreed to perform an MRI only to discover a tumor in her right sinus that was pressing on the right orbital socket. The tumor was crushing the optic nerve and surrounding the right artery to the brain. After several days of waiting for the doctors to do something my son, Aaron, checked his wife out of Houston Methodist and took her to Memorial Herman where the OB ER staff immediately jumped into action. They set Anna up for an emergency C-section and, after delivering their son at 36 weeks, performed a biopsy and partial removal of the tumor. The tumor turned out to be an aggressive form of adult Rhabdomyosarcoma

The surgeons now deemed the tumor as in-operable. The doctor has given Anna 12 to 24 months to live and they have stated the cancer is terminal and that she should be enrolled in

Sabrina is 45 with 4 beautiful children, Kenneth, Carrie, Dylan & Billie. Whilst pregnant with Billie she started to experience severe back pain & was back & fourth to the hospital, finally being diagnosed with pneumonia, a few weeks later at 30 weeks pregnant Sabrina was admitted to hospital in severe pain. She was very unwell at this stage & ended up being transferred to ICU being told on the day she turned 31 weeks pregnant "17.06.2023" that her wee baby was going to be born that they needed to deliver her as the blood flow to her baby was slowing down & Sabrina was very ill. Sabrina was then put into an induced coma, she had CT scans & the doctors said they are so glad they did not go into the lung in surgery as they knew there was something wrong. They transferred to the Royal Victoria Hospital to a lung specialist for them to have a further look into see what was going on at this stage they suspected cancer & also needed to drain the fluid from her lung, while her new baby stayed in Craigavon Area Hospital.

On the 29th of June they took Sabrina to theatre to put a drain into her lung & take the biopsy. A few days later she was moved back to Craigavon to be with her new baby so she could spend time with her whilst waiting on the results.

On the 5th of July Sabrina was diagnosed with Synovial Sarcoma on her lung with a possibility on her liver this is terminal & the outlook on time isn't great either. They have said it will be 1.5 years at a most but they don't think Sabrina will last that long.

Our baby was having a baby... Its a boy... 22 years old...

However 2 months postpartum Aaliyah had severe pain, and swelling in her right leg and on 12/21/2021 she was diagnosed with Osteosarcoma (an extremely rare cancer that affects less than 1,000 people a year in the US and that originates in the bone forming cells.) Aaliyah went through extensive chemotherapy and underwent surgery to remove the tumor and was SUCCESSFUL! As she began to finally live a semi normal life she got pregnant with her second son and began to feel uneasy about her leg and when they went in for a followup she got devasting news that the cancer had come back. Since she was pregnant and in excruciating pain she made the decision to have her leg amputated so she can finally live a normal life with her boys, then baby Khaza was born and we were overhwhlmed with joy, however Aaliyah then began suffering from neck and back pain. The pain was so severe she went to the hospital to see what was going on. The doctor then told her "i cant give you anything, you removed the cancer in your leg so (and i quote) POOF cancer is gone"!

Desperate to know why she was in so much pain she went back again and when her MRI results came in she got the heartbreaking news that she has serveral tumors in her neck and back.

On June 29th, 2023, Samantha and Anthony, while getting a routine ultrasound, received the news every expecting parents fear getting. The doctor doesn't like what they are seeing and there may be an issue with their growing baby boy. In the meantime Sam has been having some problems with a lump she found on her thigh. The doctors sent her up to OHSU for some further testing on both her and her baby. On June 30th their lives changed forever when they received the news that their baby boy was suffering from a severe case of skeletal dysplasia along with smooth brain. This meant he could not be carried to full term. Jaxson William James Brown was born then peacefully passed away on July 2nd, 2023 at 12:50pm. Two parents lost a son and two beautiful girls lost a brother. As if this wasn't devastating enough they received the results from Sam's tests and it was determined she has Stage 4 Sarcoma in her thigh and it, unfortunately, has spread to her lungs. Family and friends are rallying around this family as best they can. As expected, they need help financially with expenses related to travel to and from OHSU where she will be meeting with her physicians and receiving treatment. For those lucky enough to know Colleen knew a tenacious, witty, fun-loving woman and an incredible mother, sister, daughter, granddaughter, friend, and wife who touched every heart she encountered. But for those who didn't get the opportunity, I feel her story should be told.

Last January, while entering her second trimester of pregnancy, Colleen noticed that a spot in her knee that she had had since childhood started to become bothersome. Unfortunately, after imaging and biopsies we found out that it was a type of cancer called Clear Cell Sarcoma. <u>March 2022</u> – Everett, WA – Jackie Nishimura was diagnosed with Alveolar soft part sarcoma while pregnant with her daughter.

Early this year she learned that she was pregnant and having a girl. The first granddaughter on my Brother-in-Law Chad's side. During the last few months of her pregnancy, she was feeling pain in her back and hip, but it was considered normal pregnancy pains. Then a few months ago she had started coughing up blood and having chronic coughs. Again they attributed it to her pregnancy and saying it was caused by her acid reflux and her bouts of vomiting after eating certain meals. So we soldiered on, that was till October 1st and she started having a hard time breathing. We rushed her to the hospital, and they did a chest x-ray and found a few nodules in her lungs, one of which is 2.5 centimeters in diameter and near her airway. This now requires her to use oxygen which they have set up at home. While examining her they also noticed she had a lump on her hip. Concerned for my sister and the baby, they delivered baby Jennavieve a month early.



They then performed a full-body CT Scan and that is where they discovered what looked like a tumor on her hip and a lesion on her spinal column. My sister had a few more test they wanted to run, and after the results from the biopsy of the lump came in on October 9th they delivered the news. They are concerned it is a Stage 4 Sarcoma and they sent her samples to the Mayo Clinic. We have a preliminary diagnosis from the Mayo Clinic. Jackie has Alveolar soft part sarcoma, a very rare type of cancer. Her oncologist wants to be as aggressive as they can be, she starts phase 1 of radiation on October 21. After radiation, she will begin targeted chemotherapy. Unfortunately, there is not a Sarcoma specialist in Hawaii, so her Doctors want to refer her to a specialist in Seattle. She has healthcare from her job, but it'll only cover 20% of the cost of Cancer Treatments. That's why we decided to reach out socially, and ask for assistance.

Baby Jennavive is doing fine and they have been home with us for a couple of weeks now.

On October 25, 2023, I wrote an article on Turbo Breast Cancer in Pregnancy (20 cases). This is the second article in the series.


These articles on Turbo Cancer in Pregnancy, are "First in the World".
