August 21, 2023 (*Monday*): After teaching, Emma went to the boy's varsity soccer game, as assistant coach. Usually, Emma only goes to Thursday games. Thankfully, another assistant coach decided to switch this week.

During the game, a ballgirl kicked a ball into the back of Emma's head. The impact triggered a 2 minute seizure. This seizure was localized in her face and Emma was conscious throughout. Recently, two players moved to Timnath, and their dad made a last minute decision to come to the game instead of his wife. He happens to be a Neurosurgeon (Dr. Jon Bledsoe). During Emma's seizure, Dr. Bledsoe walked Emma through the seizure as it happened. Dr. Bledsoe strongly advised Emma to get a CT scan. A client cancelled Claire's (sister-in-law) last therapy session, so she was able to pick up Emma and Robbie (brother) to go directly to the hospital.

The CT scan revealed a tumor in Emma's brain, located in the right frontal lobe. She then received a MRI.

Travis shared this news with our knight in shining armor, Dr. Bledsoe, who connected us to Dr. Regina Bower and the Medical Center of the Rockies (MCR) for a 3:30 pm consultation at the ER.

August 22, 2023 (*Tuesday*): Emma was transferred from St. Anthony's to MCR. Close family (Trav, Ang, Robbie and Claire) met with Dr. Bower to discuss the initial MRI. Dr. Bower cleared her schedule for a Friday surgery. Emma then underwent another MRI in order for Dr. Bower and team to plan for surgery.

Emma was discharged from the hospital to be with friends and family Wednesday and Thursday nights.

Aug. 15, 2023 – Allentown, PA – Julia Dweck, a teacher, fell ill with a series of blood clots, strokes and was found to have Stage 4 pancreatic cancer.

John and Lena Upton Medical Fund

At the beginning of June, the day after turning 30 years old, John discovered he had a tumor growing in the right frontal lobe of his brain. Within the next couple of days, he was admitted to Houston Methodist Hospital where he underwent tests to determine the next steps. For nearly a month, Houston became home for John, Lena (his wife), Isabella (his then 6 week old daughter), and various family members. John's daughter Emily was also able to visit multiple times, even receiving a special stuffed animal from the hospital gift shop on her second birthday. In addition to medical bills, Lena and her girls endured the cost of living within the confines of a hospital in a big city.

As test results continued to offer more insight into the nature of the tumor, the medical team formed a treatment plan. At the hands of an excellent surgeon, John's tumor was successfully removed! Unfortunately, due to the removal of a tumor of this great size and nature, John experienced substantial cognitive regression and still needs to restore much of his physical strength.

John began to heal physically from the surgery, and the family waited in anticipation for the results of the biopsy. After some recovery time, John was healthy enough to move to the rehabilitation floor of the hospital, where he received physical, occupational, and speech therapy services. As John pressed on with rehab, more test results came in. The doctors confirmed that John's tumor is a high grade IDH-mutant glioma.

While John continues to push through four hours of therapy in the mornings and extra practice with Lena in the afternoons, the family was yet again awaiting a more definitive pathology report. Finally, the doctors were able to offer a more conclusive diagnosis of a specific glioma: grade 4 astrocytoma, IDH mutant. This particular form of brain cancer offers no cure, but does respond to treatment. As one can imagine, these treatments, coupled with the rehabilitation therapy, can be costly.


Let me fill you in on the events of this past week...

Mr. Van Curen and a few ag mechanic students went to Hewitts (a local hardware store) on Monday 5/15/23 at the beginning of 1st period. On the way back Mr. V had a seizure. The boys were quick on their feet and got the truck in park, called 911 and then me. I got there within minutes of it happening. After what felt like ages the ambulance arrived. It took him quite a while to "come to" but he was able to stand up and get on the stretcher. He doesn't remember anything except his mouth feeling funny while driving and then us asking him to sit on the stretcher. He was transported to UT North off of 155 from Winona, TX. There he got an EKG and a scan. The scan showed a 2.5" mass on the frontal lobe of the right side of his brain. They then sent him to the Neurosurgical Intensive Care Unit at UT Health (off of Beckham) in Tyler, TX.

After further testing on Tuesday, the mass was determined as a slow growing gliomas. It has been there for several years. The doctor told the family that it is terminal, due to the inability of removing the entire tumor. Thankfully, there are no other masses anywhere in his body. They operated on Thursday morning, and it took a total of 3 hours. The doctor said it was a smooth surgery, and he "removed the most that he could as safely as he could." We were able to visit with him shortly after he was wheeled to his room from surgery. He was able to move all extremities and talk with us. (Praise God!) By Friday (5/19/23) Jarrett was able to eat solid foods and make laps around the nurses station.



She underwent a 2nd brain surgery Monday, June 12. The Neurosurgeon was happy with the amount of tumor he removed. This should provide room for brain swelling that might occur during her 6 straight weeks of radiation. That will begin in a few weeks.

Lori has dedicated her career to teaching private flute lessons to hundreds of students over the years. With her chemotherapy she will have an interruption in her income.





Hi, my name is Ashley Blalock, and on behalf of our fantastic parent community at Hopi Elementary School, I am fundraising for our beloved Kindergarten teacher, Ms. Lisa Domini! To know Lisa is quite simply to love her. She has the most positively contagious and uplifting energy, and all of those young & old who come in contact with her are better for it. In 30 years, she has taught over 750 young students in the Valley, including my son and daughter. Kindergarten teachers have one of the most important and lifechanging jobs, as they help our babies become independent, confident learners in ways that we, as parents, could not.

In mid-September 2022, Lisa went to her doctor because she had sudden stomach pain and nausea. The next day her symptoms worsened, and she noticed her eyes were yellowing, so she went to the Emergency Department. They did a CT scan and identified a mass in her liver and gallbladder. Further testing identified that she has bile duct cancer (cholangiocarcinoma). This is a rare and severe condition, with only about 8,000 cases identified in the U.S. annually. Lisa has chosen her care team at the prestigious Mayo Clinic in Phoenix, AZ, consisting of top-ranked oncologists and palliative care specialists. She is still waiting for her treatment plan due to a few hospitalizations and infections that have set her treatment back. Lisa is willing and ready to kick cancer's b*tt (remember... she's a Kindergarten teacher) at a moment's notice. She has much to live for and so much love and learning to keep spreading.

Today she is a master's prepared Kindergarten teacher at Hopi Elementary in Scottsdale. She is a single mom to three accomplished college students, Ally, Andrew and Nicholas. At night she teaches online classes at the University level, helping to educate new teachers-in-the-making in this time of great need.

Why so many aggressive and inoperable brain tumors?


