Guest: **Golan Ashton**, Human Rights Attorney based in Israel, specialized in Civil Law & Labour Law.

In this session, Golan shared that during the last years, he was part of a group of activists that fought against the tyranny of the laws that made workers and citizens take injections to be able to work and support themselves.

He got a group of about 300 workers of a military-industrial company to successfully stand up against the COVID []vaxx mandate.

Now, he is suing, in numerous cases, people who, for example, made medical treatment dependent on vaccination status when that was still illegal.
